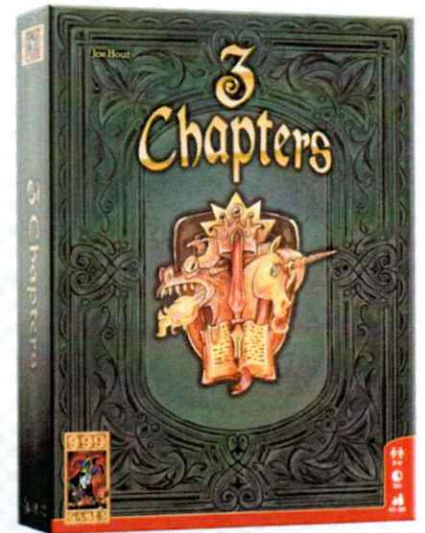


# Three Chapters Review
