Title: Mi-box live

Theme: This game is mainly focused on Math's but has some competitive elements in it. It requires luck when you roll the dice as well as knowledge. Players who don't enjoy Math's might find this game slightly boring.

How to play:

Step 1: Put the board together.

Step 2: Each player should chose a figure and place it at the starting point on the board.

Step 3: Hand out a white board and pen to each player.

Step 4: When the game is set up, one person chooses a card from the box and puts it down with the calculation facing up and the answer facing down. (Don't look at the answer.)

Step 5: Everyone should use their whiteboard and pens to work out the answer.

Step 6: When everyone is done, reveal the answer.

Step 7: Everyone who gets the question right gets to roll the dice, while people who got it wrong don't do anything.

Step 8: The number you get on the dice is the number of moves you then make on the board. (Move clockwise around the board.)

Step 9: The winner is the person who gets around the board.

Favourite part of the game: How competitive the game was. I liked the fact that you had to use your knowledge as well as chance to try and win the game.

Fun factor: I enjoyed playing this with my friends as we had fun together even though we were all trying to win. The game was exciting as the board was a bit like a racetrack and I felt excited when I got in front of everybody.
