Who would enjoy this game? Anyone from ages 6 years and above who likes Math's. I think my friends and family would like it, in particular my brother who likes Math's. This game would be better with a small group of players because you would get to have your turn faster and it would be less complicated with less people to talk to each time someone has a go.

Game components: The dice were very stereotypical, standard dice. There were two of them. The were a lot of cards to choose from which is good because it's more random and you're not likely to find a card that you've already had before. In fact, the odds would be catastrophic! The pieces were cute and quite fun to use. The bottoms of the pieces fit into holes in the board which was quite cool as you didn't have to worry about them falling over.

Would you play again? Yes, I would as I had a lot of fun with it. I felt really proud when I was the first to answer a question. I might change part of the board. It looked like a racetrack and I thought I had won when I got back to the beginning, but I hadn't. Instead of an orange bit on the board, I'd just have an arrow that said "start here2.
